However, papers are invited from all areas of applied linguistics, with a preference for papers with an empirical approach. The conference is open to all interested, but aimed specifically at postgraduates, PhD students and post-docs.

Please submit your proposal to <bael@uni-bonn.de> **by 01 March 2017**. Abstracts should be approximately 300 words long and show a clear research objective. Please include a short bio-note of maximally 100 words in your email. Speakers will be given 20 minutes for their presentation, followed by a 10-minute Q&A session. The language of the conference is English.
